This document outlines our environmental policy and how we aim to reduce the impact that our activities have on the environment.

Restore Environmental is committed to improving our environmental performance and implementing best practice to minimise the environmental impact of our operations. We will implement strategies that will reduce the impact of environmental risks on Restore Environmental and the strain on natural resources.

Policy aims include:

Implementing environmental actions within Restore Environmental
Monitoring our environmental actions and improvements
Demonstrating leadership by working with suppliers, communicating with our staff and recommending industry relevant environmental initiatives to our customers.

This policy applies to all staff. This policy may be shared with suppliers, customers and third party partners to demonstrate and share best practice.

This policy confirms our commitment to supporting the principles of environmental sustainability and recognises that a sustainable environment is central to Restore Environmental, the lives of staff, suppliers and customers and the survival of the sector as a whole.

Restore Environmental is committed to achieving a carbon neutral status and to reduce the impact that our operations have on the wider environment.

We are committed to:

Promoting environmental responsibility, communicating this to all our staff, suppliers and customers.
Assessing the environmental impacts of our operations and setting objectives and targets to reduce this impact.
Regularly reviewing environmental targets, aims and objectives to ensure that they are realistic and achievable.
Providing adequate resources to meet our commitment in this policy and the environment.
Complying with all relevant legislation and regulations.
Defining and communicating responsibilities so that everyone is aware of their individual obligations.
Ensuring that all of our policies and services are developed to complement this policy.
Taking into account environmental considerations in procurement decisions.
Reporting our environmental performance on an annual basis.

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Encouraging all our staff to use resources such as energy and water efficiently and reducing waste where possible.

Encouraging all our staff to reuse and recycle where possible.

Consider the environmental impact of travel within the organisation, encouraging lower carbon methods of transport where possible.

Offsetting our carbon emissions where we can not reduce them further.

We will also take the following additional actions:

Work with environmental specialists as required.

Encourage staff to share and promote ideas that could benefit the environment.

Monitor and reduce our consumption of raw materials and resources such as paper, water and energy.

Provide training to our staff to promote environmental improvements and benefits.

As an organisation we will share our expectation of responsibility for the environment with our staff, third party partners, suppliers and customers. Demonstrate our clear commitment to the environment by leading by example to all our stakeholders and wider society, so they may be empowered to protect the environment.

We will ensure that all our staff are aware of our commitment to the environment and encourage them to help us on this journey by being familiar with this policy.

We expect that our suppliers and partners will provide their own environmental policy to demonstrate their commitment to reducing carbon emissions and protecting the environment.

We expect that they will work with us to help reduce our joint impact on the environment.

In summary, Restore Environmental uses energy and raw resources in our day to day operations. We use chemicals such as herbicides to control vegetation such as invasive non native species. We will do everything that we can to reduce our impact on the environment. We will support our staff through training and information sharing, so that best practice can be identified and spread throughout the sector to reduce the overall impact on the environment. We encourage all our staff, suppliers, partners and customers to think about the environment and do what they can to minimise their effect on it.
